

## Milton Keynes Revetment Repair



After a number of failures of the slope underneath a road bridge, a contract was let to F J Morris by Milton Keynes Council to repair the revetment.

Shotcrete was employed to install a 125mm thick reinforced concrete slab over a consolidated sub-base. The steep angle of the slope required sprayed concrete to be applied in bays with movement joints.

The works were carried out expediently to ensure the road could be re-opened to traffic.
